



***NMRFAM Protein Structure Determination Workshop
Residence Hall Accommodations: June 4-10, 2017***

Reservations are being taken for accommodations in [Dejope Hall](#), a University residence hall located at 640 Elm Drive. Rooms are available either as double or single occupancy, all with single/twin beds. Maximum occupancy is two persons per room. Dejope Hall will be open to receive guests beginning Sunday, June 4, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. and will be available until 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 10, 2017.

Sleeping Accommodations and Amenities:

- Bed linens, pillows, blankets, towels, washcloths, drinking cups, and soap are furnished.
- Free high-speed (wired and wireless) Internet and digital TV connections are available in the guest rooms for your electronic devices.
- All rooms are air-conditioned and have a small refrigerator.
- Rooms will be cleaned, beds made and towels changed daily.
- Floor lounges provide large televisions and comfortable seating to relax and socialize.
- Computers are available for use on the first floor.
- Laundry facilities, vending and ice machines are provided on the first floor.
- All facility areas are smoke-free, including guest rooms. Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is not allowed within 25 feet of any University building.
- No parking is available at the residence halls. Please refer to your program registration materials for information regarding parking arrangements.
- All guests must follow [campus policies](#).

Bathrooms: Guest rooms do not have private bathrooms, but bathroom facilities serve five to six guest rooms immediately adjacent. These shared facilities include private shower and restroom stalls. Bathrooms will serve a designated gender, and a unisex bathroom is available on each floor. We recommend that all guests bring a bathrobe, slippers/flip-flops and a case to carry your personal items.

Desk Services: Dejope Hall has a staffed 24-hour desk service on the main level. Guests receiving calls should instruct family and friends to call 608-890-4895 during their stay. Messages will be placed in mailboxes near the hall desk as there are no in-room phones. Irons, ironing boards and recreational equipment are available for check-out on a first-come, first-served basis. Please return after each use, so other guests may use these items. Laundry soap, postage stamps and other items are for sale.

Rates: The rate for double occupancy is \$56.50/night per person and single occupancy is \$34.00/night per person. *Payment must be made in full at the time of reservation. University Housing accepts American Express, Discover, MasterCard, and VISA.*
